## Editors Reply,

The DMP 3160, DMP 3000 and the DMP 4000 are compatible with the CPC range of machines but unfortunately this problem can occur with certain programs. The solution can be achieved in one of two ways.

1) Alter the DS1-4 to 'OFF', this will cancel out the line feed signals.
2) Remove the casing on the lead at the edge connector end and cut line 14. This can be found by noting the position of the numbers e.g.


Using this positioning we can find out that PIN 14 is located at *.
