

AMSTRAD V21/23 MODEM

One of the major growth areas in the field of computers is in computer communications - the ability to connect two or more computers together over considerable distances to exchange or access information using a standard public telephone line. Unfortunately, as always, several standards have evolved. Help is however at hand in the shape of the Amstrad V21/23 modem, this will enable you to connect your Amstrad computer to a British Telecom type 600 socket*. It offers full V21/23 protocol and a range of receiving and transmitting baud rates to enable connection to all the standard Databases and information services, such as Prestel, B.T. Gold, BLAISE and Micronet.



In addition to the modem with B.T. connecting plug and lead, you are supplied with a lead to connect to your Amstrad computer and a voucher entitling you to the 1st quarters subscription to both Prestel and Micronet 800 free of charge.
