This is to acquaint you with the information that fills the "Basic Software Library". This Library is the most comprehensive work done of its kind to date. There are other software books on the market today but they are dedicated to computer games. The intention of this work is to allow the average individual the capability to easily perform useful and productive tasks with a computer. All of the programs contained within this Library have been thoroughly tested and executed on several systems. Included with each program is a description of the program, a list of potential users, instructions for execution and possible limitations that may arise when running it on various systems. Listed in the limitation section is the amount of memory that is required to store and execute the program in K Bytes.

Volume I contains Business and Recreational programs and is 300 pages long. Volume II is 260 pages long and contains Math, Engineering, Statistics and Plotting programs. Volume III contains money managing Advanced Business programs such as Billing, A/R, Inventory, Payroll, etc. All the volumes are printed on standard 8½" x 11" paper.
